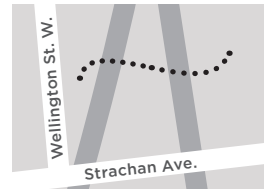


CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

CONSTRUCTION OF THE GARRISON CROSSING (FORMERLY THE FORT YORK PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE BRIDGE) IS UNDERWAY.

The new bridge crossings will connect the surrounding park system and communities with Fort York and the waterfront. As a result of this work there may be noise, dust and temporary inconveniences in and around the work sites. We appreciate your patience as we undertake this important city building project.

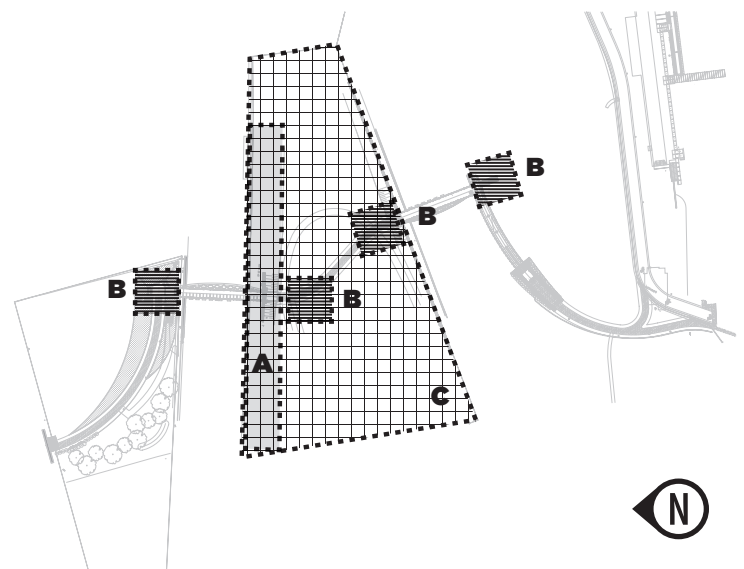
WORK ON THE GARRISON CROSSING IS OCCURRING IN 3 PHASES:

PHASE 1: AUGUST 2016 - MAY 2017

- A** Construct a retaining wall in Ordnance Park
- B** Construct bridge supports in Ordnance Park, Garrison Common and South Stanley Park Extension
- C** Place fill in Ordnance Park to facilitate grading (work completed as part of Ordnance development)

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Construction activities will take place during the day (7am to 7pm).
- This includes installation of foundation piles, which we can expect to produce a fair amount of noise and minimal dust.



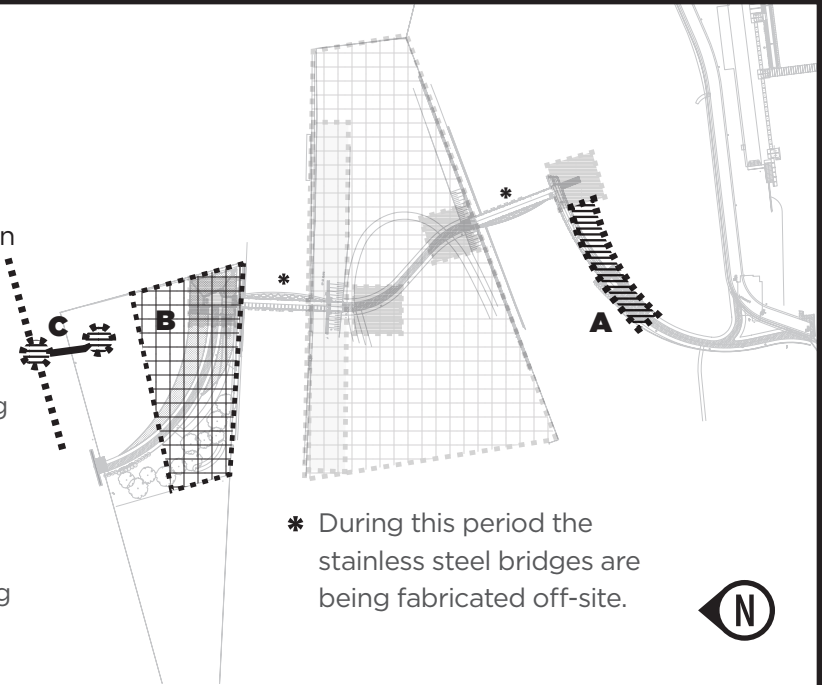
CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

PHASE 2: JUNE 2017 - MARCH 2018

- A** Complete ramp into Garrison Common
- B** Place fill on a portion of South Stanley Park Extension to facilitate grading
- C** Construct the storm sewer connection from South Stanley Park Extension to the Wellington Street storm sewer to facilitate drainage

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Construction activities will take place during the day (7am to 7pm), with some work being done at night (7pm to 7am).
- There will be minimal impact to pedestrian access to the Fort York grounds during the ramp construction into Garrison Common.
- There will be minimal impact to traffic during the construction of the storm sewer on Wellington.

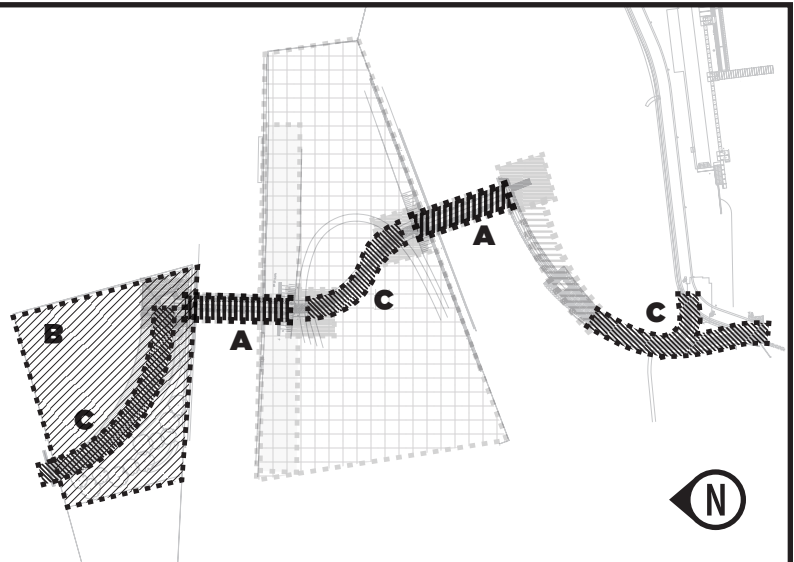


PHASE 3: APRIL - JULY 2018

- A** Steel assembly, installation of bridge structures and pouring of bridge decks
- B** Complete placement of fill and landscape in South Stanley Park Extension to attain base park condition
- C** Complete trail paths

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Construction activities will take place during the day (7am to 7pm).
- The preparation for and installation of the bridge structures will be completed at night (7 pm to 7 am).
