Brian Doucet, Filmmaker, Author and Associate Professor of Planning at the University of Waterloo

We are excited to welcome Filmmaker, Author and Expert on Housing, Transportation and Neighbourhood Change, Professor Brian Doucet, to keynote UWPAT's 32nd Annual Toronto Planning Dinner.

Brian's keynote will explore the root causes of our current housing crisis, highlight transformative solutions, and describe the important roles that the public, private and third sectors can play by collaborating to bring about real change.

Born and raised in Toronto, Brian has a deep understanding of planning and life in our City and Region. Having studied housing for over 15 years in Canada, the Netherlands, and the United Kingdom, Brian's keynote will build upon his research and expertise to identify highlights (and lowlights) of local and international planning practices and solutions which extend beyond the housing market.

Brian is an Associate Professor at the University of Waterloo. In 2017, he was awarded the Canada Research Chair in Urban Change and Social Inclusion by the Government of Canada. Brian has published extensively, including multiple books, having edited *Why Detroit Matters: Decline, Renewal and Hope in a Divided City*, co-edited *Global Reflections on COVID-19 and Urban Inequalities* and co-authored *Streetcars and the Shifting Geographies of Toronto: A Visual Analysis of Change*. Brian is also frequently interviewed and published in the media including on CBC, TVO, the Toronto Star and Spacing Toronto.
